Our city is also hard at work transforming the tragedy of the Christmas Day 2020 bomb into a tremendous opportunity. We're grateful to Metro Council for prioritizing the redevelopment of Second Avenue and the riverfront with a \$70 million commitment. The future for our urban core with this and many other investments is nearly beyond what's imaginable.







FIRSTBANK FIRST SATURDAY ART CRAWL

Since 2019, the Partnership has partnered with lead sponsor FirstBank to produce and promote the long-running First Saturday Art Crawl. Despite COVID-19 challenges and the ever-growing downtown retail landscape, the event remains a uniquely Nashville offering each month to thousands. In 2022, there were 15 participating locations throughout downtown.

CHURCH STREET PARK

Church Street Park serves as a "backyard" to thousands of downtown residents, employees and visitors. The Nashville Downtown Partnership successfully completed a management, operations and programming pilot in cooperation and coordination with the Historic Capitol Corridor Foundation. In the fall, NDP reached an agreement with Metro Parks to continue the clean, safe, active and attractive operating model through 2027. Church Street Park will continue to be a vibrant community asset offering free resources and events to all.

EMERGING LEADERS NETWORK: BUILDING CONNECTIONS FOR DOWNTOWN'S TOMORROW

Launched this year with participation and enthusiasm from the board of directors, the Emerging Leaders Network connects the Partnership with early- and mid-career associates. Through quarterly networking and educational opportunities, NDP is able to identify and cultivate a diverse group of promising future leaders and downtown advocates. NDP board members nominated the first class of participants, who enjoyed presentations and panel discussions tackling downtown topics.

FITDOWNTOWN

Launched in the summer of 2021, FitDowntown aims to bring downtown residents, employees and local visitors together, encouraging creative and active use of the neighborhood through fitness practice. FitDowntown hosted 18 events this year within the downtown core. Participants came from 33 ZIP codes throughout the state.

DOWNTOWN NEIGHBORS ASSOCIATION

The Downtown Neighbors Association was born from the former Urban Residents Association and revitalized for 2022 and beyond. Beginning with social outings for residents, the DNA grew to host regular monthly meetings throughout the downtown core. DNA events are open to all downtown residents and provide a space to connect with neighbors, engage with community advocates and encourage civic involvement. Whether offering an opportunity to connect with elected officials or to mingle with neighbors over refreshments, regular DNA events are vital as the residential population continues to skyrocket.

GETTING AROUND

IN DOWNTOWN

Downtown Nashville is the epicenter of our community's evolving conversations around mobility, transit demand management and curbside management solutions. The Partnership is both a driving partner and a liaison to resources for getting around downtown.

"PARKIT! DOWNTOWN" PARK-AND-RIDE SHUTTLES

Thousands of employees ride these "last mile" shuttles from Nissan Stadium into the heart of downtown each month. NDP has operated shuttles for 20 years!

PARKING WAYFINDING

The 'Where to Park' page of NashvilleDowntown.com received 189,000 web sessions, assisting people with important information related to parking options, locations and rates.

CONNECT DOWNTOWN STUDY

Connect Downtown is a joint project of the Nashville Department of Transportation (NDOT), WeGo Public Transit, the Nashville Downtown Partnership and the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT). The study identifies projects, programs and policies that can be implemented to manage downtown's congestion and improve mobility. The study completed six listening sessions to engage stakeholders and understand critical issues.

SPECIAL EVENT TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE

The "ParkIt! Downtown" shuttles assisted in 100+ special event service days, transporting passengers for Tennessee Titans and Nashville Predators games, Music City Grand Prix, Nashville Area Chamber of Commerce events, and other Nashville agency events.
